

Lasagna "NO DIG" Gardening

Mark out your plot, and then break ground with fork to encourage drainage. Lay the cardboard down to smother the weeds, making sure to overlap the edges. Remove staples and anything metal.

Water each layer as you put it in place.

Separate the straw, and add in transplants.

Source for organic, local materials.

Lasagna Layers

Water each layer as you add materials in this order. Add new material each year.



separate straw and insert plant

- top layer of straw or weed free hay
- soil and compost mix
- brown layer of leaves
- green grass layer
- soil and compost mix layer - amend with rock dust and clay
- green grass layer
- brown hay layer (for carbon)
- soil and compost mix
- put kitchen scraps and worms in middle
- green grass (for nitrogen)
- cardboard layer - remove staples, overlap edges, water well

fork ground to allow drainage
